

## St Paul's Church of England Primary School, Wolverhampton WV9 5NR



The governors and headteacher of St. Paul's Church of England Primary School, Wolverhampton propose changes to the end of the school day to take effect from 4<sup>th</sup> September 2018.

- The school day for all pupils presently commences at 8.55 am and this will remain unaltered.
- It is proposed that lunchtime will be reduced by 15 minutes which will still ensure that pupils have sufficient time to eat and play positively and happily.

For pupils in our Reception class lunchtime will be 12 noon – 1pm

For pupils in KS1 (Years 1 and 2) lunchtime will be 12 noon – 1pm

For pupils in KS2 (Years 3,4,5 and 6) lunchtime will be 12.15 pm – 1pm.

There will be no changes to contracted times for any members of staff, including lunchtime supervisors.

### **The proposed time of the end of the school day will be 15 minutes earlier:**

For pupils in our Reception class the end of the school day will be **3.10pm**

For pupils in KS1 (Years 1 and 2) the end of the school day will be **3.10pm**

For pupils in KS2 (Years 3, 4, 5, and 6) the end of the school day will be **3.15 pm**

There is no set minimum teaching time for EYFS, KS1 and KS2 set out by the Department for Education. Archived guidance previously suggested a minimum of 21 hours for KS1 and 23.5 hours for KS2.

This proposal ensures that:

- pupils in KS2 will receive 26.25 hours of teaching and learning each week
- pupils in KS1 will receive 25 hours of teaching and learning each week
